### County Deer Advisory Council (CDAC) Meetings

The 2018 spring CDAC meetings have begun in each county. Early April is the public comment period. Final antlerless deer permit quotas for the 2018 season will be set during the week of April 16th – 19th and final county proposals will go to the Natural Resources Board in May. To provide comment or info on upcoming meetings, go to the DNR website and search “CDAC”.

### 2018 Licenses Available

New hunting, fishing, and trapping licenses are now being sold. All 2017 licenses expire March 31st. Antlerless deer permits will not be available until the summer, after CDACs have determined permit levels. Hunters that purchase a deer hunting license prior to that will need to go back at a later date and select their antlerless deer authorizations.

### Boat & ATV/UTV Registrations Expire

Boat and ATV/UTV registrations will expire on March 31st depending on your year of expiration. A temporary operating permit will allow immediate operation for registrations renewed online on the DNR website, at DNR service centers or at registration agents.

### Spring Hearings

The DNR Spring Wildlife & Fisheries Informational Hearings will take place on Monday, April 19th at 7:00 p.m. If you'd like to review this year's questionnaire, go to the DNR website and search “Spring Hearings”. Hearing locations

### New Fishing Regulations

A variety of new fishing regulations take effect in SE Wisconsin beginning April 1st. Be sure to check the county-specific regulations in the center of the regulations pamphlet.

### Proposed Waterfowl Season Changes

Public input is being sought for proposed waterfowl season changes. Some of these changes include a regular season daily bag limit of three geese, moving the northern zone duck opener one week later (same as southern opener), elimination of the Horicon goose zone, and a possible second split to the southern zone goose season to push the season into early January. ### Elk Hunting Season

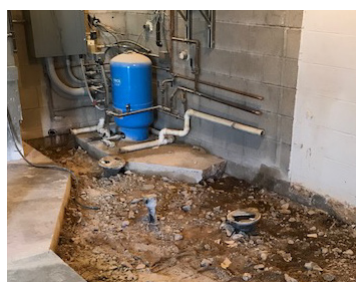
