This 100-target American Singles Trap event is open to any currently registered Scholastic Clay Target Program (SCTP) youth shooting team (current team registrations are valid through the end of August, 2018). All teams must register and select squad times through the SSSF SHOT portal at www.sssfonline.org. **Registration will open on July 9th, 2018** (midnight the 8th into the 9th) and **will close on August 17th, 2018**. Within seven days of registering, please generate your team voucher and send a copy, along with payment of \$175.00 per squad of five athletes or \$35.00 per individual athlete, made payable to WWST to the address above. **We reserve the right to remove unpaid squads from the schedule after one request for payment.** Your team will be liable for not less than the number of athletes registered when registration ends on August 17th.

We will use TEAM scoring with the SCTP American Classification System for team awards. Awards will be given to the top three squads in the combined Intermediate classifications, Junior Varsity and Varsity classifications. In addition, individual male and female awards will be given to the top three Rookie, Intermediate Entry, Intermediate Advanced, Junior Varsity and Varsity athletes.

New This Year - Coaches Challenge. We're opening up a division for SCTP registered coaches and volunteers to compete against one another. You can squad with athletes, or as groups of adults. Awards will be given to the top three male and female coaches / volunteers.

Squads will shoot 25 targets on each of four fields, all beginning on trap four and moving to trap one in succession. Please arrive one hour prior to your squad times and check in at the Youth Training Center. All SCTP rules for safety, dress code, academic standards and competition will apply to this event. All teams must be supervised by their head coach or designee. No "on-field" coaching is allowed: athletes and shoot workers only beyond the yellow tape.

Food, beverages and raffle items will be available at the club throughout the shoot.
