Spring Turkey Harvest

Turkey hunters registered 38,556 birds during the 2019 spring season, just slightly lower than the 2018 harvest. This was the second lowest harvest in 20 years and a 15% decrease from the long-term average. The overall success rate was 18.1%. This trend is consistent with a large area across the country and there are currently no concerns. Zone 1 again led the turkey harvest, followed by Zone 3 and then Zone 2.

Snowmobile Registrations Expire

Snowmobile registrations will expire on June 30th depending on your year of expiration. Registrations can be renewed online on the DNR website, at DNR service centers, at registration agents, or by mail.

Application Deadline

August 1st is the deadline for many DNR permit applications, including fall turkey, goose, bobcat, fisher, otter, and sharp-tail grouse. Applications can be submitted online, by phone, or at a DNR license agent.
